#### Betty Crocker's One Skillet Spaghetti

1 lb ground beef
1 cup chopped onion
½ cup of sliced mushrooms (optional)
1 can (28 oz) tomatoes or home canned tomatoes
½ cup chopped green pepper
½ cup of water
2 teaspoons of salt
1 teaspoon sugar
1 teaspoon chili powder
7 oz of thin spaghetti, broken into pieces
1 cup of shredded Cheddar cheese (4 ounces)

Cook and stir meat, onions, and mushrooms (if desired) in large skillet or Dutch oven until meat is brown. Drain off fat. Stir in tomatoes (with liquid) and remaining ingredients except Cheddar cheese; break up tomatoes.

TO COOK IN SKILLET: Heat mixture to boiling. Reduce heat; cover and simmer, stiring occasionally, until spaghetti is tender, about 30 minutes. (A small amount of water can be added if necessary.) Sprinkle with cheese. Cover and heat until cheese is melted.

TO COOK IN OVEN: Pour mixture into ungreased 2 or 21/2 quart casserole. Cover and bake in 375 degree oven until spaghetti is tender, about 40-45 minutes. Uncover; sprinkle with Cheddar cheese and bake about 5 minutes longer to melt the cheese.
