When I read the email describing Workshops for this year's annual meeting, I knew I wanted to attend if I could. Workshop choices included A Psalm Spirituality of Music and Adventure, God is an Arist and You Can Too, The Labyrinth, Do I really Have to Worry about Copyright?, How to Increase Worship Attendance In Your Church, and Fill Your Cup to the Brim: Hands-On Worship How-To's to name a few.

I asked if I could attend as a delegate and received the go-ahead, so Saturday, June 8, I headed out to Green Lake Conference Center at 6:30 a.m. for a fun filled adventure. I chose to attend workshops titled: "God is an Artist and You Can Too!" and "A Psalm Spirituality of Music and Adventure". Both were inspirational and gave me ideas to bring back to ECUCC to share with others, so I look forward to discussing ideas with anyone who wishes to run with art and music ideas presented. The Plenary Session turned out to be the Business Agenda for the Conference. The session I attended covered a report on the search process for Conference Ministers, introduction of the interim Conference Minister, a presentation of the Conference Open and Affirming Resolution and a presentation by Rev. Barbara Holmes, the new president of United Theological Seminary.

The resolution I voted in favor of involves moving toward declaring Wisconsin Conference UCC an Open and Affirming Conference. The full text of the ONA resolution was shared. I learned the process for adopting resolutions calls for a vote of the annual meeting followed by one year of study by the local congregations, and a confirming vote at the next year's annual meeting. I hope to be a delegate again next year so I can vote for Wisconsin Conference UCC to be an Open and Affirming Conference.

Thanks for the opportunity to be a delegate and to learn more about the UCC Conference process. Next year, I hope to attend with another member to share the experience.
