Home Health United has community grief support groups and hospice volunteer trainings upcoming in the Janesville area.

Grief continues well after loss occurs and each individual experiences it in unique ways. It is not uncommon for grief to come in intense waves, especially within the first year. Many find it helpful to talk with others going through similar experiences. To support you during this time, Home Health United is offering "When Mourning Dawns" grief support groups to anyone in the community who has experienced a loss. The groups are offered at no cost to participants.

The "When Mourning Dawns" grief support groups take place on Thursdays, January 23-February 26, from 3-5pm at St. Mary's Janesville Hospital (3400 E. Racine Street). This grief support explores the various "seasons" of grief. Pre-registration is required, and a minimum number must be registered for the group to take place.

Due to increasing demand, HHU – Hospice has a continued need for volunteers in all communities in Rock County. Volunteers are needed in both administrative and patient-interactive areas. Upcoming training sessions include Wednesday, February 26th from 8:30am-4:30pm at Home Health United – Janesville (3700 E. Racine Street).
