On March 12th from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. we will be volunteering, as a church, by spending time at "Cornerstone of Hope" which is associated with Habitat for Humanity at 320 East Milwaukee Street, Janesville WI.

There are two opportunities for volunteers: Sorting seeds, or Lumber labor. All tools and materials necessary will be provided by Cornerstone of Hope at the Habitat for Humanity Warehouse at the Janesville location.

Assembling Seed Packets:

Dividing bulk seeds into individual packets. Label packets.

Place packets in manilla envelopes.

Building the Raised Garden Beds:

Cut the lumber to size – an adult (18yrs or older) would have to do that. Then drill pilot holes for screwing them together Then wrap the 4 pieces together with shrink wrap Attach a packet of screws And then stack them on the trailer.
