Frosted Pineapple Cookie Recipe

These cookies were a big hit at the Harry Potter Festival and Connie Tronnes asked Norma Thompson to share the recipe with all of us. Give them a try, especially with the upcoming Thanksgiving Holiday. Thank you for sharing, Norma.

FROSTED PINEAPPLE COOKIES

can (8 oz.) crushed pineapple
cup shortening
cup packed brown sugar
egg
tsp. vanilla extract
cups all-purpose flour
1/2 tsp. baking powder
1/4 tsp. baking soda
1/4 tsp. salt
1/2 cups confectioners' sugar

Drain the pineapple, reserving 3 Tbs. juice for frosting; set aside. In a mixing bowl, cream shortening and brown sugar. Add egg; mix well. Add pineapple and vanilla. Combine flour, baking powder, baking soda and salt; gradually add to creamed mixture.

Drop by teaspoonfuls 2 inches apart onto greased baking sheets. Bake at 325 degrees for 17-20 minutes or until golden. Remove to wire racks to cool.

In a small bowl, mix confectioners' sugar with enough of the reserved pineapple juice to achieve a smooth spreading consistency. Frost cooled cookies YIELD: 3 doz.
