
Meeting of the Board



CHURCH COUNCIL MINUTES Monday, November 12, 2018 7:00 p.m. - 7:50 p.m.

PRESENT: Erin Smerchek, Lukas Jensen, Julie Norland, Norma Thompson, and Bruce Morris

ABSENT: Tracy Tronnes, (Deacon rep. Holly Gould), and Pastor Lori Powell

CALL TO ORDER: Julie Norland called the meeting to order and led us in prayer.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Julie Norland entertained a motion to approve the Council minutes of October 8, 2018. Lukas Jensen made a motion to approve the Council minutes, as written, and Erin

Smerchek seconded the motion. Vote taken. Motion carries.

**SPECIAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING HELD ON NOVEMBER 4, 2018:** A special meeting was held on November 4 after church service to vote on hiring Rev. Lori Powell as the new Edgerton Congregational UCC's half-time minister. A paper ballot vote (Yes: 39, No: 1) was in favor of hiring Pastor Lori.

**PASTOR'S REPORT:** Pastor Lori has already introduced herself to the peanut crew at church and to various organizations in Edgerton (Edgerton Community Outreach and Rotary, etc.). Pastor Lori and Diane Goodger's PCs are running very slow and working poorly. The Trustees need to review this issue. Pastor Lori plans to work with Laura Young to resurrect the church's choir and in finding special music for worship. Pastor Lori has ask Council members to consider "What three priorities do you see as most important to the Pastor's role at this time?" This item will be part of December's council meeting.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1. Fundraising idea for 2019 Possibly doing some type of fundraiser during Edgerton's 2019 Parade of Lights on the Saturday following Thanksgiving each year.
- Budget Committee A Budget Committee is being pulled together to create the church's budget for 2019. Bruce Morris, Tracy Tronnes, and Lukas Jensen (Trustee rep.) will serve on the committee. A representative from the Deacon's team is still needed along with a memberat-large representative. Calls will be placed by Council members to recruit others to work on the Budget Committee.
- 3. Nominating Committee The Church Council is in the process of recruiting church members to serve on the Nominating Committee.
- 4. Annual Meeting The church's 2018 Annual Meeting is scheduled for Sunday, January 27, 2019.

### OLD BUSINESS:

1. Membership Rolls - Discussion of church membership rolls has been tabled until the next Council meeting which will be held on Monday, December 10.

**TREASURER:** Church checking account is holding steady.


