

Pentecost, the church's birthday, is a time to reflect on what "the church" is. In an age of distance and fear, it is important to remember the essence of Pentecost: togetherness.


We can connect even when we are apart by all wearing red or bringing a candle to this Sunday's Facebook LIVE worship.


