On Sunday, October 13, 2013 a special congregational meeting was held to amend the church constitution and officially adopt an Open and Affirming covenant. The vote was unanimous, with three abstentions. By adopting this covenant, our congregation solidified our commitment to going beyond "All Are Welcome" and truly embody St. Paul's admonition to "love one another, just as Christ has accepted you."
