## FRIENDS OF JAMS

Friends of Jane Adeny Memorial School (JAMS) is a non-profit organization, founded in 2013, to promote and support the Jane Adeny Memorial School in Kenya, Africa. Their vision is to educate girls and transform the world.

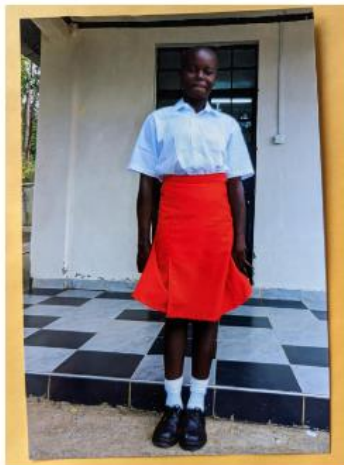
By addressing the financial barriers that would normally keep girls from attending secondary school, JAMS and Friends of JAMS are answering the recommendation by the World Bank and the Global Campaign for Education to address financial issues to allow for greater gender equity in education.

Teaching methods, school governance, curriculum, and living conditions are all designed to empower the girls and develop effective life skills and leadership qualities. JAMS is grounded in a holistic philosophy: we care about the whole child, her emotional, physical, and intellectual well-being.

ECUCC proudly supports JAMS by funding a scholarship for Joyvilla Achieng. The cost for Joyvilla's education is \$800 per school year. We receive letters twice a year from Joyvilla about her education and life, and we send notes and letters to her at school.

We encourage our congregation to prayerfully consider contributing to her scholarship fund. Any contributions may be made to the church with "JAMS Scholarship" in the memo line.
